



RWCID POOL MEMBER RULES, REGULATIONS & REGISTRATION

1. RWCID Resident Pool Memberships are available to all who own property or reside full-time within the District. RWCID residents must submit the RWCID Resident Annual Pool Registration form each year to become an RWCID Pool Member. Children in college whose permanent address is in Robinwood West are considered Resident Members.
2. RWCID Non-Resident Pool Memberships are available to a limited number of people who do not live in the District and are at the discretion of the RWCID Board of Directors. Interested Parties must submit the Non-Resident Pool Member Application form each year to become an RWCID Pool Member.
3. Residents and Non-Residents may submit their forms and proof of residency/identification in May of each year. The Pool Membership Desk will be staffed prior to pool opening and during the first two weeks of the season. Operating hours will be provided on the RWCID website and in the Round Robin. Upon completion of the registration/application process, RWCID Pool Member ID Cards will be renewed. New ID cards will be issued as necessary and for first-time members. Effective with the 2009 Pool Season, a \$2 fee will be charged to replace lost ID cards.
4. Requirements for admission to the RWCID Pool:
 - a. At least one Pool Member from each family must complete the RWCID Pool Member Daily Sign-In at the pool entrance near the Snack Bar.
 - b. Each Pool Members' ID Card must be presented to the lifeguard or Snack Bar attendant at each visit. In the event that a representative is not available at the pool entrance, Pool Members will present their ID card to the lifeguard on duty.
 - c. Children under the age of 12 or less than 48 inches tall must be accompanied at the pool by an adult or "childcare" provider (14 or older). Paid childcare providers are not required to pay a Guest Fee as long as they are acting as an agent of the Member Family. If any child or childcare provider is removed from the pool, all children with the childcare provider must leave.
 - d. Admission will be refused to all persons appearing to have a contagious or infectious condition, under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or cannot provide appropriate proof of membership.
5. Pool Members may invite Pool Guests under the following guidelines:
 - a. Pool Guests are accompanied by Pool Members and signed-in at pool entrance.
 - b. Pool Members are responsible for ensuring their Pool Guests have paid the Guest Fee at the Snack Bar. Each Pool Guest, two (2) years and older, is subject to a \$2 fee. Guest Pass Punch Cards are available as a special benefit for Pool Members, offering a discounted Guest Fee. See Item 7 for details.
 - c. A Member Family may host up to five (5) Pool Guests provided they supply supervision by a Member over 18 years of age. Those members under 18 are limited to two (2) Pool Guests per visit.
 - d. Each Pool Guest may attend only five times each year.
 - e. A Pool Member wishing to bring more than five (5) Pool Guests at any time must seek approval through the RWCID Pool Liaison. Written request and approval are required. (Provisions for large parties are available through the pool rental schedule.)
6. Pool Guests are defined as:
 - a. Friends or family of RWCID Pool Members who are not registered as a Resident or Non-Resident Pool Member.
 - b. Grandchildren of RWCID **Resident** Pool Members are exempt from the Guest Fee. Resident Pool Members must designate their guests' relationship on the Guest Registration form.
7. Only Pool Members may purchase **Guest Passes**. **Guest Pass Punch Cards** may be purchased at the Snack Bar and are available as follows:
 - o 10 visits for \$15 (a savings of \$5)
 - o 20 visits for \$25 (a savings of \$15)

The RWCID Pool Member must sign the Guest Pass Log **and** show their Pool Member ID Card when purchasing Guest Passes. Payment is due at time of purchase. Pool Guests cannot purchase Guest Passes.



8. RWCID Pool hours are Tuesday through Sunday, 12 Noon to 8 p.m. The pool is closed on Monday. If a holiday falls on a Monday and the RWCID Pool is open, then the pool will be closed the next day, Tuesday. Schedule changes will be posted for all to observe. The RWCID Pool Liaison and/or the pool management company may close the pool for maintenance purposes, health conditions, weather, or any other reason deemed necessary.
9. The RWCID will post all signs in accordance with St. Louis County.
10. Food and/or drink may not be consumed or served on the lower level. Food and beverages served or consumed in designated areas shall be in unbreakable containers. No coolers or alcoholic beverages.
11. Smoking is allowed only in the designated smoking area. A smoking urn is provided. These procedures will help to eliminate trash and second-hand smoke. No one under 18 is permitted to smoke.
12. Glass bottles or containers are not allowed inside the fenced pool area including pool decks, dressing rooms and playgrounds.
13. No firearms or weapons of any kind are allowed on RWCID property.
14. The RWCID Community Center, bathrooms and kitchen are off-limits except for private rentals and scheduled events.
15. Use of any pool equipment and/or toys within the pool area (e.g., balls, rafts, water guns, etc.) must be approved by the lifeguard on duty. All RWCID equipment, toys and supplies shall be returned to the proper storage area after each use.
16. Lifeguards have authority to ensure pool safety for all Pool Members and Guests and to ensure compliance with the posted RWCID Pool Rules of Conduct and RWCID Pool Member Rules, Regulations & Registration. Lifeguards work for and are supervised by the pool management company. Lifeguards do not provide oversight of the playgrounds, volleyball area and adjacent parks. Use of these areas is at the risk of the individual parents and/or guardians of each child. Proper supervision is to be provided by the parents and guardians.
17. Submission of false information by RWCID residents or non-residents to gain membership or access to the RWCID Pool shall be considered sufficient grounds for a temporary or permanent suspension from the pool. Failure to comply with instructions of the pool staff or designated RWCID representatives and/or violation(s) of any of the posted *RWCID Pool Rules of Conduct* and *RWCID Pool Member Rules, Regulations and Registration* may result in a temporary or permanent suspension of pool privileges. Under no circumstances will a suspended Pool Member be due a refund of any fees, etc., previously paid to the District.
