



2010 RWCID POOL RULES OF CONDUCT

- Parents and guardians are responsible for the conduct of their children/guests and for ensuring children can swim. Lifeguards may administer a deep water test at their own discretion.
- Swimmers who require the aid of flotation devices must remain in the shallow end or the wading pool.
- No running, pushing, fighting, shoving, dunking or rough play. No climbing fences.
- No profanity, improper behavior or intoxication allowed.
- No smoking, eating or beverage consumption allowed while in the pool.
- No pets or other animals allowed in the pool or pool area (except registered guide dogs).
- No bicycles, scooters, skateboards, roller blades, etc., allowed in the building or within the fenced area.
- Deck hoses are for use by authorized staff only.
- Only authorized personnel are allowed in the Snack Bar and lifeguard office and on the lifeguard stand.
- Use the shower before initial entry to the pool. When returning to the pool from the playground or sand courts, use the hose/sprayer located near the “shower tower” by the deep end of the pool.
- Diving and Diving Board Rules:
 - Diving is only allowed in designated areas.
 - Use of the diving well is prohibited while others are using the diving board.
 - Only one person on the diving board at a time.
 - No sitting, double bouncing or handstands allowed on the diving board.
 - Divers must remain on the ground until the previous diver has exited from the diving well.
 - Divers must use the ladder when exiting the pool from the diving well.
 - No sunglasses or flotation aids allowed while using the diving board.
- Waterslide Rules:
 - Only one person on slide at a time, including ladder.
 - Wait until the previous user has left the water *under the slide* before climbing the waterslide ladder.
 - Swimmers must slide down feet first and no sitting/standing on the bottom of the slide is permitted.
 - No swimming under waterslide allowed while in use by others.
 - No sunglasses or flotation aids allowed on waterslide.
 - Water flow valve shall be changed by the lifeguards or pool management only.
- Wading Pool Rules:
 - Lifeguards are not responsible for anyone in the Wading Pool.
 - Children should be closely supervised and within arms reach.
 - Children not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper. The Snack Bar has swim diapers for sale.
 - No sitting or standing allowed on fountains or bubblers.

Failure to comply with the safety instructions of the pool staff, designated RWCID representatives, the posted RWCID *Pool Rules of Conduct*, or the posted RWCID *Pool Member Rules, Regulations & Registration* may result in a temporary or permanent suspension of pool privileges. Under no circumstances will a suspended Pool Member be due a refund of any fees, etc., previously paid to the District.
